- o Photo ID for all household members age 18 and over.
- o Social Security cards and Birth Certificates for all household members.
- o Proof of Income
- o Pay stubs (for last thirty days)
- o Employment letter (hrs, pay date(s), wages/salary)
- o Award Letter from Social Security office
- o Any other documentation of income
- o Proof of Assets such as bank statements or inheritance award letters
- Lease Agreement
- o Eviction Notice and/or Court Documents

## What do I need from my landlord?

- o Rental License also called a Housing Inspection License
- o Certificate of Rental Suitability
- o W-9 signed by landlord
- o Letter with current rental balance signed and dated by landlord
